Responsibilities:

1. Enhance information or entertainment values of productions by collaborating with producers concerning layout or editing approaches
2. Present story with maximum effect by selecting and combining the most effective shots, into sequences and correct errors using editing tools.
3. Enhance video content, programs, interstitials and promotions by editing video to include dialogue, music and sound effects and by rendering graphics and animation elements.
4. Set up and operate non-linear editing systems, electronic titling, video switching and digital video effects to produce a final product
5. Maintains communication with Producer and supervisor by submitting status reports.
6. Contributes to team effort by accomplishing related results as needed

Requirements:

- College Certificate/Diploma in Broadcast Video or Media Production or equivalent experience
- Minimum 2 years industry related experience
- Working knowledge of non-Linear Editing system software; Adobe Premiere, graphics applications such as Adobe After Effects and Photoshop
- General knowledge of audio editing software - Pro-Tools and iZotope
- Advanced knowledge of signal routing, scopes, linear editing, and general television operational procedures
- High proficiency with optimum video and audio levels, quality control, and general television broadcast technical standards
- General knowledge of Microsoft Office suite
- Works independently and under low supervision
- Strong written and oral communication, strong interpersonal skills
- Exceptional storytelling skills, with ability for idea generation with imagination and creativity
- Good organizational skills and accurate program time calculation abilities
- Displays strong attention to detail and factual presentation of information
